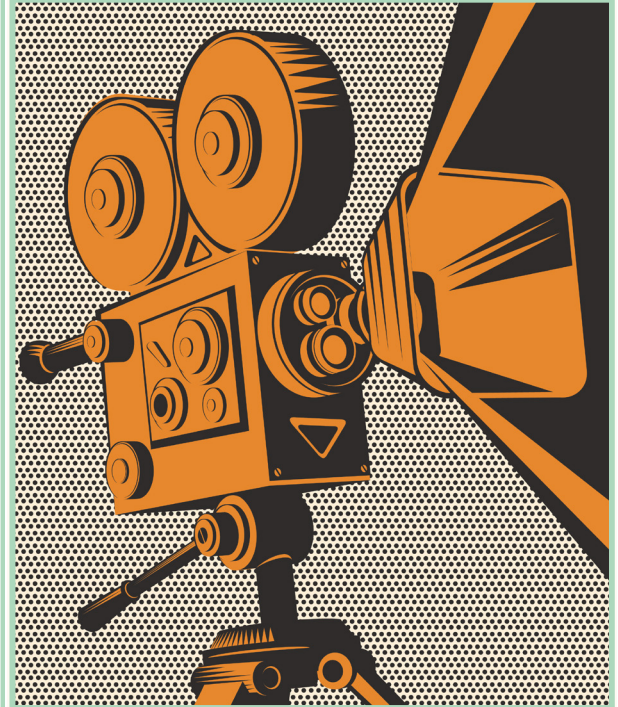

Companies wishing to film on any public street and/or property in the Town of Oyster Bay must submit the completed, signed and notarized application form, appropriate insurance, required fees and a statement of consent from every resident on the block.

FEES

ALL FILMING.....\$800.00 per day
Includes all of the following:

- Motion Pictures/Television Programs
- Television Commercials
- Commercial Still Photography

BASE CAMP FIREMAN'S FIELD.....\$500.00 per day
Separate from filming location or Town of Oyster Bay Parks Facility.

STUDENT FILMING.....NO FEE

Additional fees will be charged by the Department having jurisdiction and oversight of the facility

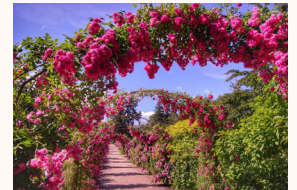
